## MEMBERSHIP RULES

### Your Community Pantry Membership:

- 150 memberships are available at the FwL Community Pantry; conditions apply.
- Membership is awarded on a first come first served basis and any applications received after meeting the 150 available will be placed on a waiting list.
- *Membership is open to those who are in receipt of state benefits; proof required.*
- *Membership entitles you to **one visit to the community pantry per week.***
- Membership is restricted to one per household, proof of where you live must be provided when applying e.g. a utility bill.
- Membership fee is a fixed amount each week; currently **£5.00** but may be subject to periodic change. You can pay by cash.
- Membership use is **reviewed every 3 months.**
- Membership of the Pantry is only for the residents of the **London Borough of Hounslow** who meet the eligibility criteria.

### The Community Pantry reserves the right to cancel or refuse your membership. For example:

- If you do not use the pantry in **over a three week period**
- You move away from the area
- You are found to be abusive towards pantry volunteers or other users

If membership is cancelled due to non-attendance you can reapply but may be placed on a waiting list.

### How the pantry works:

- Members must pay the fee of **£5.00** each time they want to shop.
- Your weekly membership allows you to choose at least 12 items from a variety of groceries plus fruit and vegetables. The average basket of items is worth around £35 to £40 at retail value.
- Items available in the pantry may vary from week to week due to the different supplier the Pantry uses.
- There is no guaranteed availability of any item from week to week.
- To ensure that members get a fair share of stock available; we may limit some items to one per member / visit.

### About the food:

- If you suffer from food allergies or intolerances and are unsure about the ingredients in a product, please ask one of the trained members of staff for further information.
- The Pantry may receive some food products that come without labelling, however in these cases the pantry will endeavour to provide a list of ingredients on a separate ingredient sheet. Should you require one of these, please ask a pantry volunteer.
- The Pantry may also stock items which have passed their best before date. Best before indicates quality, not safety. When this date has passed, it doesn't mean that the food will be harmful. These items will be clearly marked.
